

Russell Canada Prize at Innis College: 2020-2021 Cycle

Established in 2018, the aim of this award is to reflect the work of Peter H. Russell and encourage students to seek out, as he does, the unique character of our country.

Eligibility

To be awarded annually to currently registered undergraduate Arts & Science students. Preference will be given to Innis College students. International and domestic students are welcome to apply.

How to Apply

The deadline to apply is **19 April 2021 at 11:59 p.m.** Applications must be sent electronically to the **Innis College Registrar's Office** (registrar.innis@utoronto.ca) from your UTmail+ account.

- Parts to the Application:
- Completed **application form** (page 2 of this package);
 - An outstanding "**production**" on some aspect of Canada in the form of a substantial piece of coursework (e.g., essay) or a substantial creative work (e.g., poetry, prose, drama, film, painting, or photography). Candidates are expected to use their best judgement with regards to modes of submitting their creative works. The review committee will want to experience and assess said content within a reasonable amount of time. Please do not include your student number on your production submission.

Awarding Body

The award body is the Innis College Council. A committee that will include the Principal of Innis College, a student representative of Innis College Council, and potentially one or two others representing the College or the Russell family (as decided by the Principal and the student representative) will adjudicate submissions and make a recommendation to the Recruitment, Admissions & Awards Committee who will in turn make a recommendation to the Innis College Council.

Value

The approximate value is expected to be \$1,000.

Results

Students can expect to hear results by July. The award will be paid out sometime in the summer session.

Awards are paid directly to outstanding fees first. Please ensure that you have added [direct deposit](#) in ACORN or that your mailing address on ACORN is up to date, as award cheques may be mailed to that address.
